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Wind (Beaufort Scale)

- 0 = calm/flat seas
- 1 = ripples without crests
- 2 = wavelets, crests not breaking
- 3 = large wavelets, few whitecaps
- 4 = small waves with breaking crests, frequent whitecaps
- 5 = moderate waves of length, many whitecaps, small amounts of spray
- 6 = long waves form, moderate spray

Precipitation

- N = none F = fog
- D = drizzle R = rain

Beach Conditions

Wrack:

- 0 = none
- 1 = light; scattered along tide line
- 2 = moderate; continuous, but light along high tide line
- 3 = heavy; continuous and heavy along high tide line

Human activity:

- 0 = none
- 1 = scattered; not affecting bird abundance
- 2 = moderate, but birds have usable areas without humans
- 3 = heavy; strongly affecting bird abundance

Garbage

- 0 = none
- 1 = light; scattered mainly among wrack
- 2 = moderate; heavy along wrack line
- 3 = heavy; throughout beach
